Curriculum Coverage for Autumn Term in Year 5/6

We have lots of exciting learning planned for Autumn Term 2024.

In science, we will be learning about properties of materials and seeing light.

At home you could talk about things that can change state (solids, liquids and gases) around the home and how light travels in straight lines.





Our first geography unit is looking at the United Kingdom. We will be learning about counties, towns and cities as well as geographical features in the UK.

In history, we will be learning about World War Two.
